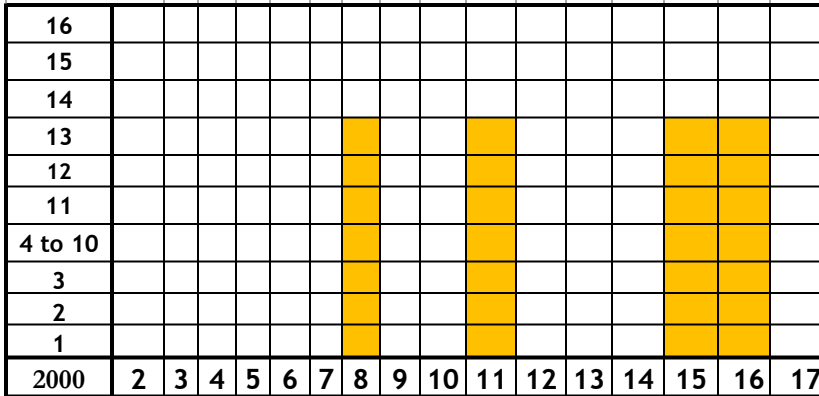


Calcium Readings in mg/L April 19, 2017

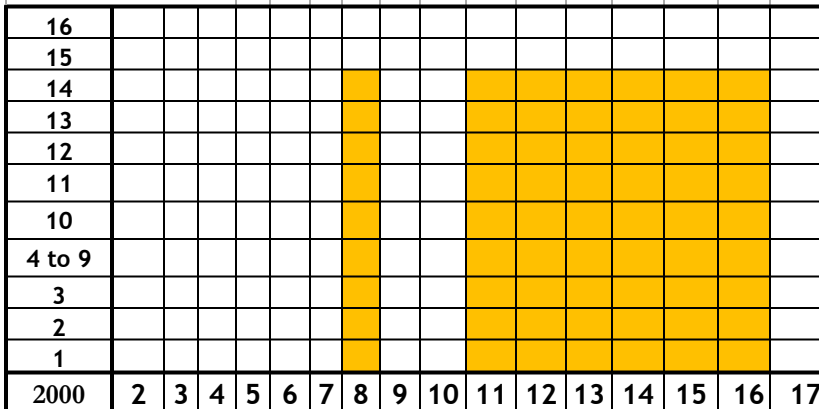

LONG LAKE

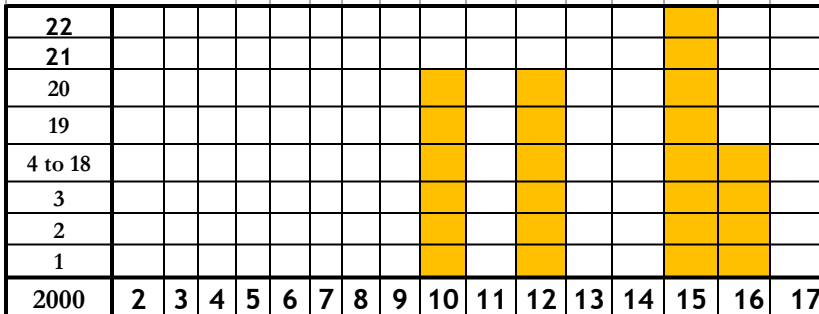


Calcium is required by all species. Absolutely necessary for aquatic ecosystems. Water fleas (zooplankton) are important to lake systems. They feed on algae and provide food for fish and Invertebrates. Low calcium levels (below 1.5 mg/L) result in a decline in Zooplankton. 10% of 49 lakes tested in Hamilton County have less than 1.5 mg/L.
